



Narratives of family and self

'I am a descendent of the 4th son of the Zhouwen Emperor of the Zhou Dynasty.'

'I am part of the elite: the golden-collar class. Father's father and father's mother, mother's father and mother's mother were all from the landlord class.'

'I am an egg laid under the Red Flag. Both my husband and I were unaffected in the past by the various movements led by the CCP. We were part of the privileged class. Before China's reforms, we were masters. Now it is hard to define ourselves. But we are still part of the upper class – we have never left.'

'One grandfather was a New 4th Army Hero. His father worked in the government and was a member of the CCP. The Family Tree goes back to the Spring-Autumn Era. We share ancestors with Mao Zedong. We still keep contact with that family and visit them.'

'I agree with the idea of the "elite class" leading society.' 'I don't attach importance to money, since I don't sense any crisis. I just want to do things.'

'Economically I am middle class but I have a great reputation in the community.' 'I had the chance to be village secretary for the CCP branch but was not interested.' Father a local CCP Leader. Paternal grandfather had a textile business, the other was from a former landlord family '

'Father was a policeman, mother a doctor. All four grandparents were long-term members of the CCP. Paternal grandfather was county road management head. Maternal grandfather from a landlord family, a CCP member, cadre in hydro-electric plant.'

'I never thought about my class description and am just a normal person. I am a professional manager and get on well with employees. I have been called elite in the software industry.' 'It is said that we are the offspring of Cai Wenji.'
