

JOB DESCRIPTION

Discipline : Private Law (section 01 CNU).

The position is that of a senior professor of universities (Professeur.e des universités senior). At the time of the appointment, candidates must have acquired the status of Professor in the French academic system or an equivalent tenured rank in a foreign university.

Candidates are specialists of procedural law and its various aspects, and is open to interdisciplinary aspects of the field, as well as to its critical approaches.

The candidate will engage in collective research and demonstrates, through his/her research and publication track record, his/her capacity to develop a thorough theoretical thinking and to address different scientific and professional communities.

The candidate has a significant visibility at the French level demonstrated by his/her publications, individual and collective research works and his/her integration in research networks. He or she will have an excellent knowledge of the professional circles related to the French judiciary environment. Some involvement in European and international networks will also be appreciated.

As part of its gender equality policy, Sciences Po encourages applications from women.

FUNCTIONS

Research

The selected candidate will be conducting his/her research within the Law School. He/she will develop his/her research through engagement with domestic networks, through participation in the law school's academic life and events (seminars, doctoral supervision, research collaborations and programs, etc.), and through contribution to editorial activities within his/her fields. As he/she will participate to activities of the Law Department and Law School, he/she will have a deep knowledge of the French academic world, a real experience in getting research funding and a capacity to develop collaborations with partners external to Sciences Po.

Teaching

Annual teaching duties are 128 master class equivalent (CM) hours that can be divided into three 24-hour master classes and 56 CM hours of complementary pedagogical services at the three levels of teaching offered by Sciences Po: college (on one of the seven Sciences Po campuses), Master's (within one of the seven professional schools of Sciences Po), and doctoral studies.

Candidates must demonstrate their ability to teach foundational and advanced courses in procedural law, in an innovative manner, as well as their willingness to contribute to the supervision of doctoral theses. Candidates will be expected to teach in French and/or in English.



Management and Administration

The candidate will contribute to the management of existing masters, notably the diverse programs preparing students for judiciary careers, as well as to the creation and development of new curriculums of the law school. He/she has the capacity to conceive and supervise high-level training and education projects aimed at professional circles, as well as individual and collective research projects.

PROCEDURE

Applications

Candidates must submit their application on the "Galaxie" portal of the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research **before November 25th at 4 pm, (Paris time)**

Applications should include the following:

- A cover letter presenting the candidate's intended research agenda;
- A CV and a full list of publications;
- Three significant publications;
- A synopsis and, where possible, evaluation of previously taught courses.

All applications will be reviewed by the selection committee in order to pre-select 3-4 candidates, who will be invited to present their research to the academic community at a job talk at Sciences Po.
