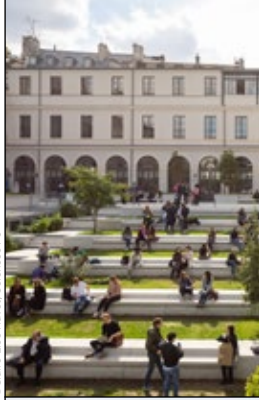

## STANDARD COURSE OF STUDY

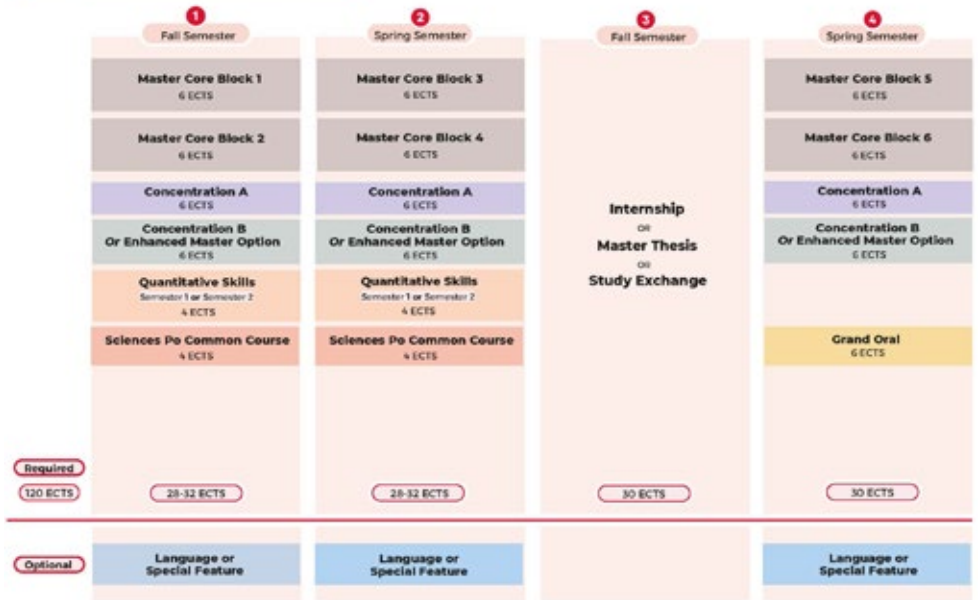
The PSIA degree structure is organized as follow:

Course offered in each Master specialisation become progressively more advanced semester by semester;

Students are expected to devote five hours to independent, in-depth study in their chosen courses for each hour they will spend in the classroom. In other words, students should spend 125 hours working outside the classroom for each 24 hours spent in the classroom.

Some 80% of students follow a two-year program at PSIA.
